The National Debt Workshop:
Making the Difficult Policy Choices to Improve America's Long-Term Fiscal Outlook

"Principles & Priorities" is an interactive exercise in which participants learn about how difficult it is to balance the federal budget by making many of the policy decisions facing lawmakers today. Working on 'special budget committees,' participants consider issues such as federal spending priorities, and tax policy thereby gaining firsthand experience addressing the difficult issues facing policymakers in today's fiscal (and political) environment. They then recommend a package of policies to put America on a sound fiscal foundation for the next several years.

What You Will Learn:

Economics - How will your decision affect the economy in the short-term & long-term?

Public Policy - What segment of the population – taxpayers, seniors, students, etc. - wins or loses by your choices? What makes for good and fair policy?

Politics - How will voters respond to your decisions?

Principles and Priorities - Do you think the federal government is too big, too small, or the right size? Which areas of federal government deserve more or less funding? Now and for the future?
