Preference will be given to applicants who:

- ✓ Live in the 5th District
- ✓ Teach at a public or private school in the 5th District
- ✓ Teach grades 9-12 during the 2025-2026 school year

Applicants must be available to arrive in Washington the afternoon of Sunday, July 12, 2026 in order to arrive first thing Monday morning for orientation, and must commit to staying for the duration of the entire internship. This is a paid internship. The 2026 salary is \$3,000.00 before taxes. The selected intern is responsible for making all transportation and lodging arrangements.
