

2024 PROGRAM SUMMARY

Congresswoman Virginia Foxx is pleased to announce her 15th annual Teacher in Congress Internship. The internship will be conducted in the Congresswoman's Washington, D.C. congressional office during the period July 19-26, 2024, and consists of learning activities, including an introduction to the legislative process; tours of the U.S. Capitol, Library of Congress and area museums; briefings with House committee staff; and attending hearings, mark-ups and floor debates.

Preference will be given to applicants who:

- ✓ Live in the 5th District
- ✓ Teach at a public or private school in the 5th District
- ✓ Teach grades 9-12 during the 2023-2024 school year

Applicants must be available to arrive in Washington the afternoon of Friday, July 19, 2024, for orientation and stay for the duration of the entire internship.

To be eligible for consideration, applications must be received in the Congresswoman's office no later than close of business Friday, June 14, 2024.

Applicants should submit a completed 2024 Teacher in Congress Internship application form, accompanied by a cover letter, resume and sample lesson plan. Applications are also available online at www.foxx.house.gov/teachers. Each application will be reviewed and one teacher will be selected to participate in the 14th annual Teacher in Congress Internship. Applicants will be notified by email of the selection results after June 15, 2024. Additional information, such as schedule of events and payroll documents, will be provided to the participating teacher(s) prior to July 19, 2024. Assistance will be offered to arrange renewal credit where applicable. However, the selected intern(s) is/are responsible for making all transportation and lodging arrangements.
