

## Pro-Israel Legislation *I Have Co-Sponsored* from the Current Congress

[H.RES.798](#): Condemning the support of Hamas, Hezbollah, and other terrorist organizations at institutions of higher education, which may lead to the creation of a hostile environment for Jewish students, faculty, and staff.

- Introduced on October 19, 2023, by Rep Burgess Owens (R-UT)
  - **I was an original co-sponsor of this legislation.**
- Last action: Passed on November 2, 2023

[H.Res.771](#): Standing with Israel as it defends itself against the barbaric war launched by Hamas and other terrorists.

- Introduced on October 11, 2023, by Rep Michael McCaul (R-TX)
  - **I was an original co-sponsor of this legislation.**
- Last action: Passed on October 25, 2023

[H.R.6940](#): Israel Anti-Boycott Act

- Introduced on March 3, 2022, by Rep Lee Zeldin (R-NY)
  - **I was an original co-sponsor of this legislation.**
- Last Action: Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

[H.Res.881](#): Condemning the heinous terrorist attack on Congregation Beth Israel in Colleyville, Texas, on January 15, 2022. (Condemns anti-Semitism)

- Introduced on January 20, 2022, by Rep Beth Van Duyne (R-TX)
- Last Action: Passed on March 8, 2022

[H.R.2748](#): Israel Relations Normalization Act of 2021

- Introduced on April 21, 2023, by Rep Brad Schneider (D-IL)
- Last Action: Ordered to be Reported by Voice Vote

[H.R.261](#): Palestinian International Terrorism Support Prevention Act of 2021

- Introduced on January 11, 2021, by Rep Brian Mast (R-FL)
  - **I was an original co-sponsor of this legislation.**
- Last Action: Referred to the Committees on Foreign Affairs and Financial Services

[H.Res.1110](#): Supporting the announcements of the establishment of full diplomatic relations between the State of Israel and the United Arab Emirates and the State of Israel and the Kingdom of Bahrain, and for other purposes.

- Introduced on September 15, 2020, by Rep Eliot Engel (D-NY)
- Last Action: Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

[H.R.5595](#): Israel Anti-Boycott Act

- Introduced on January 13, 2020, by Rep Lee Zeldin (R-NY)
  - **I was an original co-sponsor of this legislation.**
- Last Action: Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

[H.R.1837](#): United States-Israel Cooperation Enhancement and Regional Security Act

- Introduced on March 21, 2019, by Rep Ted Deutch (D-FL)
- Last Action: Passed House on July 23, 2019

[H.Res.246](#): Opposing efforts to delegitimize the State of Israel and the Global Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions Movement targeting Israel.

- Introduced on March 21, 2019, by Rep Brad Schneider (D-IL)
- Last Action: Passed House on July 23, 2019

[H.Res.72](#): Rejecting anti-Israel and anti-Semitic hatred in the United States and around the world.

- Introduced on January 23, 2019, by Rep Lee Zeldin (R-NY)
- Last Action: Referred to the Committees on Foreign Affairs and Judiciary

[H.R.336](#): Strengthening America's Security in the Middle East Act of 2019

- Introduced on January 8, 2019, by Rep Michael McCaul (R-TX)
- Last Action: Referred to the Committees on the Judiciary; Financial Services; Science, Space and Technology and Armed Services

[H.Res.835](#): Supporting robust relations with the State of Israel bilaterally and in multilateral fora upon seventy years of statehood, and for other purposes.

- I introduced this resolution on April 18, 2018
- Last Action: Passed House on May 10, 2018

[H.R.5141](#): United States-Israel Security Assistance Authorization Act of 2018

- Introduced on March 1, 2018, by Rep Ileana Ros-Lehtinen (R-FL)
- Last Action: Referred to the House Committees on Foreign Affairs; Armed Services; and Science, Space and Technology

[H.R.1697](#): Israel Anti-Boycott Act

- Introduced on March 23, 2017, by Rep Peter Roskam (R-IL)
- Last Action: Referred to the Committees on Foreign Affairs and Financial Services

[H.Res.11](#): Objecting to United Nations Security Council Resolution 2334 as an obstacle to Israeli-Palestinian peace, and for other purposes.

- Introduced on January 3, 2017, by Rep Ed Royce (R-CA)
- Last Action: Passed House on January 5, 2017

[H.Res.729](#): Expressing support for the expeditious consideration and finalization of a new, robust, and long-term Memorandum of Understanding on military assistance to Israel between the United States Government and the Government of Israel.

- Introduced on May 13, 2016, by Ileana Ros-Lehtinen (R-FL)
- Last Action: Passed House on September 13, 2016

[H.Con.Res.107](#): A concurrent resolution denouncing the use of civilians as human shields by Hamas and other terrorist organizations.

- Introduced on July 16, 2014, by Rep Ileana Ros-Lehtinen
  - **I was an original co-sponsor of this legislation.**
- Last Action: Resolving Difference in the House and Senate

[H.Con.Res.30](#): Recognizing the 65th anniversary of the independence of the State of Israel.

- Introduced on April 10, 2013, by Rep Trey Radel (R-FL)
- Last Action: Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

[H.R.938](#): United States-Israel Strategic Partnership Act of 2014

- Introduced on March 4, 2013, by Rep Ileana Ros-Lehtinen (R-FL)
- Last Action: Became Public Law on December 19, 2014

[H.R.4133](#): United States-Israel Enhanced Security Cooperation Act of 2012

- Introduced on March 5, 2012, by Rep Eric Cantor (R-VA)
- Last Action: Became Public Law on July 27, 2012

[H.Res.268](#): Reaffirming the United States' commitment to a negotiated settlement of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict through direct Israeli-Palestinian negotiations, and for other purposes.

- Introduced on May 13, 2011, by Rep Eric Cantor (R-VA)
  - **I was an original co-sponsor of this legislation.**
- Last Action: Passed House on July 7, 2011

[H.Res.1765](#): Supporting a negotiated solution to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict and condemning unilateral measures to declare or recognize a Palestinian state, and for other purposes.

- Introduced on December 15, 2010, by Rep Howard Berman (D-CA)
- Last Action: Passed House on December 15, 2010

[H.R.5327](#): United States-Israel Rocket and Missile Defense Cooperation and Support Act

- Introduced on May 18, 2010, by Rep Glenn Nye (D-VA)
  - **I was an original co-sponsor of this legislation.**
- Last Action: Passed House on May 20, 2010

[H.Con.Res.260](#): Recognizing the 62nd anniversary of the independence of the State of Israel and reaffirming unequivocal support for the alliance and friendship between the United States and Israel.

- Introduced on May 13, 2010, by Rep. Ileana Ros-Lehtinen (R-FL)
- Last Action: Referred to the House Committee on Foreign Affairs

[H.Res.1241](#): Supporting the right of Israel to defend itself against terrorists and the Israeli construction of new security fences along the border of Egypt.

- Introduced on May 13, 2010, by Rep. Scott Garrett (R-NJ)
  - **I was an original co-sponsor of this legislation.**
- Last Action: Referred to the House Committee on Foreign Affairs

[H.Res.557](#): Expressing support for the State of Israel's inalienable right to defend itself in the face of an imminent nuclear or military threat from Iran, terrorist organizations, and the countries that harbor them.

- Introduced on June 18, 2009, by Rep Pete Sessions (R-TX)
  - **I was an original co-sponsor of this legislation.**
- Latest Action: Referred to the House Committee on Foreign Affairs

[H.Con.Res.111](#): Recognizing the 61st anniversary of the independence of the State of Israel.

- Introduced on April 28, 2009, by Rep Scott Garrett (R-NJ)
- Latest Action: Passed House on May 4, 2009

[H.Res.34](#): Recognizing Israel's right to defend itself against attacks from Gaza, reaffirming the United States' strong support for Israel, and supporting the Israeli-Palestinian peace process.

- Introduced on January 8, 2009, by Rep Nancy Pelosi (D-CA)
  - **I was an original co-sponsor of this legislation.**
- Latest Action: Passed House on January 9, 2009

[H.Con.Res.322](#): Recognizing the 60th anniversary of the founding of the modern State of Israel and reaffirming the bonds of close friendship and cooperation between the United States and Israel.

- Introduced on April 4, 2008, by Rep Nancy Pelosi (D-CA)
- Latest Action: Passed House on March 23, 2008

[H.Res.951](#): Condemning the ongoing Palestinian rocket attacks on Israeli civilians by Hamas and other Palestinian terrorist organizations, and for other purposes.

- Introduced on January 29, 2008, by Rep Scott Garrett (R-NJ)
  - **I was an original co-sponsor of this legislation.**
- Latest Action: Passed House on March 5, 2008

[H.Res.758](#): Urging Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas, who is also Chairman of his Fatah party, to officially abrogate the 10 articles in the Fatah Constitution that call for Israel's destruction and terrorism against Israel, oppose any political solution to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, and label Zionism as racism.

- Introduced October 18, 2007, by Rep Roy Blunt (R-MO)
- Latest Action: Referred to the House Committee on Foreign Affairs

[H.Res.557](#): Strongly condemning the United Nations Human Rights Council for ignoring severe human rights abuses in various countries, while choosing to unfairly target Israel by including it as the only country permanently placed on the Council's agenda.

- Introduced on July 19, 2007, by Rep John Campbell (R-CA)
- Latest Action: Passed House on September 25, 2007

[H.Res.467](#): Condemning the decision by the leadership of the University and College Union of the United Kingdom to support a boycott of Israeli academia.

- Introduced on June 6, 2007, by Rep Patrick Murphy (D-PA)
- Latest Action: Passed House on July 11, 2007

[H.Con.Res.131](#): Commemorating the 40th anniversary of the reunification of Jerusalem.

- Introduced on April 25, 2007, by Rep Joe Wilson (R-SC)
- Latest Action: Referred to the House Committee on Foreign Affairs

[H.Res.107](#): Calling for the immediate and unconditional release of Israeli soldiers held captive by Hamas and Hezbollah, and for other purposes.

- Introduced on January 1, 2007, by Rep Gary Ackerman (D-NY)
  - **I was an original co-sponsor of this legislation.**
- Latest Action: Passed House on March 13, 2007

[H.Res.601](#): Condemning in strongest terms Iranian President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad's hateful rhetoric directed toward Israel.

- Introduced December 14, 2005, by Rep Tom Cole (R-OK)
- Latest Action: Referred to the House Committee on Foreign Affairs

[H.R.4681](#): Palestinian Anti-Terrorism Act of 2006

- Introduced February 1, 2006, by Rep Ileana Ros-Lehtinen (R-FL)
  - **I was an original co-sponsor of this legislation.**
- Latest Action: Referred to the House Committee on Foreign Affairs
