



## 2023 PROGRAM SUMMARY

Congresswoman Virginia Foxx is pleased to announce her 14<sup>th</sup> annual Teacher in Congress Internship. The internship will be conducted in the Congresswoman's Washington, D.C. congressional office during the period July 21-28, 2023, and consists of learning activities, including an introduction to the legislative process; tours of the U.S. Capitol, Library of Congress and area museums; briefings with House committee staff; and attending hearings, mark-ups and floor debates.

Preference will be given to applicants who:

- ✓ Live in the 5<sup>th</sup> District
- ✓ Teach at a public or private school in the 5<sup>th</sup> District
- ✓ Teach grades 9-12 during the 2022-2023 school year

Applicants must be available to arrive in Washington the afternoon of Friday, July 21, 2023, for orientation and stay for the duration of the entire internship.

To be eligible for consideration, applications must be received in the Congresswoman's office no later than close of business Friday, June 9, 2023.

Applicants should submit a completed 2023 Teacher in Congress Internship application form, accompanied by a cover letter, resume and sample lesson plan. Each application will be reviewed and one teacher will be selected to participate in the 14<sup>th</sup> annual Teacher in Congress Internship. Applicants will be notified by email of the selection results after June 10, 2023. Additional information, such as schedule of events and payroll documents, will be provided to the participating teacher(s) prior to July 21, 2023. Assistance will be offered to arrange renewal credit where applicable. However, the selected intern(s) is/are responsible for making all transportation and lodging arrangements.
